# Why bike?

Bike to School Week 2019 is a free, fun, week-long celebration for students who have taken part in Pedal Ready training.

School participation in Bike to School Week enhances sustainability curriculum, builds community, and highlights the benefits of active transportation - like less congestion and healthy, energised students.

## How can you get involved?

- Put up a poster display and share info with whānau
- Share on Facebook and in newsletters that your school is biking this week
- Get a student bike or travel committee going
- Hold mini activations such as a bike fix up with parent volunteers, or give out stickers, stamps or passport cards for those who bike
- Set up a cycling school train (like a walking school bus but with bikes!) with whānau/community volunteers
- Talk to your council's road safety person about holding a Milo breakfast or getting goodies!
- Share the safety flyer for students provided
